SUNDAY READING REFLECTIONS

Ordinary Time – 15th Sunday – B 2018 [Mark 6:7-13] Packing Light

Fran and I returned from our vacation. It was a long trip, but we packed lightly, neither of us allowing ourselves more than could be packed into one medium suitcase and one carry-on. It was a wise decision and each of us used everything we brought. (Several times!) Although always appropriate and tasteful, did I ever get tired of seeing my beloved in that same black and gray outfit! I suggested she burn it when we got home, never to be worn again.

In this week's Gospel according to Mark, Jesus sends his Apostles out and admonishes them to pack light. This is probably because Jesus wanted them to focus more on the important message they were to bring than on creature comforts or fashion.

When we pray, it is better, I think, to focus on the important thing: closer communion with God, rather than a long litany of memorized words. It is better to take time to listen to the Lord than to do all the talking. Pack light and bring only what is essential. Our Father already knows all our needs and our concerns. And he provides the means, well before we ask. Long prayers are harder to carry, anyway.

My friend and mentor, Thomas Merton, has said it better than ever I could. I quote him once again: The best way to pray is: stop. Let prayer pray within you, whether you know it or not. This means a deep awareness of your true inner identity. There are no levels. Any moment you can break through into the underlying unity which is God's gift in Christ.
